
## **ASSEMBLY GUIDE**





# Before you start . . .

WARNING: Installation should be performed by a competent person only. This product could be dangerous if incorrectly installed. Check the pack and make sure all the components are included - if not, call the Manufacturers' Helpline on 01769 575500 and their team will get things sorted. When you are ready to start make sure you have the right tools to hand, plenty of space and a clean dry area for building. Don't rush, read the instructions first and run through the sequence before you begin. Assembly should be done in the stages shown in the following diagrams, constructing one unit at a time and keeping fittings together to avoid loss. Lay large panels on the floor using the packaging for protection. Do not over tighten screws.

Cleaning - Use mild soap and water only. Do not use abrasive cleaners.




In order for this 1000mm Base Cabinet to function as a corner unit, you must position the end of this Base Corner Cabinet 127mm away from the adjacent swall surface.




Please note at this point if you are building a drawer line unit it is advisable to fit the drawer runners at this stage.

If fitting the standard drawer boxes please use the pre marked positions on the cabinet.

If you have chosen upgraded drawer boxes or framed doors, refer to the instructions supplied with the drawer box



Connect base panel 3 onto side panel 1 as shown. Repeat for top panels 2.





#### Using as a sink base

If you intend to use this 1000 base cabinet as a sink base, it is important to reduce the height of the back panel and position the back rail away from the sink bowl and service pipework. This Kitchen Collection base unit has a generous 76mm service void, behind its back panel to accommodate all types of service pipework.

- Assemble your base unit as described in steps 1 - 8 but with the back rail fitted in the alternative position as shown in the illustration for step 3. Use fixings provided.
- Slide the back panel into position and move the assembled cabinet into place. Mark the height of pipework onto the back panel and then remove the back panel for trimming to allow free pipe access.


Reinsert the back panel into the cabinet, as shown in the diagram (to the right)




4. In this instance, if the drawer support rail is required, it should be secured to the underside of the work surface, using suitable fixings (not supplied), at the rear of the unit.






Fit central post 4 and secure with 4 x c screws.

If fitting the drawer support rail to this unit, ensure that the holes in the rear face of central post are at top of unit. Fix 1 x A and 1 x 6 to these holes.






Depending upon desired drawer configuration, fit drawer runner supplied in 500 drawer system to face A / B.



If you have chosen upgraded drawer boxes or framed doors, refer to the instructions supplied with the drawer box





Connect drawer support rail onto central post 4. Fix back of item with 2 x screws , tighten clockwise at front to fully secure drawer support rail



Slide in back panel 5 into groove.
Carefully drill through panel 5 into the edge
of the top rail 2 and secure using 2 x 3 screws.

Now affix your cabinet legs






To join cabinets together mark 20mm on a 3mm dia. drill bit with masking tape.

Drill between the 2 holes drilled for the hinges, through one cabinet side (16mm) and 4mm into the next, stopping when you reach the marker.

Join the cabinets together with  $2 \times \mathbb{R}$  screws.



Use appropriate fittings to secure cabinet to wall (depending on wall type).



If you have chosen framed doors, refer to the instructions supplied in the separate hinge pack for frame fixing, fitting and adjustment of hinges.


Separate hinge from hinge plate if supplied attached.




Edge of pane

Affix hinge plate M to cabinet using pre-drilled holes with pre-mounted screws.

Connect door hinge to cabinet and tighten screw shown.





After adjustment is complete apply cover plate N

#### To fit shelves Push shelf suppor into chosen shelf position holes, 5 per shelf. Tilt and slide in shel-

### To fit plinths

Lay plinth panel in front of cabinet. Position plinth clip plate S opposite front cabinet legs. Secure with 2 x screws **B**. Slide Pinto S Stand plinth up.

#### To fit door handles

Position your choice of handle (available separately) using the drilling guide available in stores.
